Use Hydrogen Peroxide to Treat Bacteria Full strength hydrogen peroxide can be used and will kill the bacteria that causes black spots on orchid leaves. Simply soak a Q-tip with hydrogen peroxide and dab affected area (s). Avoid swabbing underneath the leaf, as this may kill the leaf.

Unpot the orchid and remove the old media; remove all the mushy or dead roots, and spray the whole plant with Hydrogen peroxide 3%. Let air-dry for a moment, and then wipe off any excess water left behind. Repot the orchid in a clean pot using fresh media. Make sure not to pot the orchid too deep in the media, as we want the crown to stay dry.

To treat crown rot, simply pour a small amount of hydrogen peroxide over the affected area. To prevent orchid crown rot, when watering your orchid, just water the roots – wet the potting media, but not the orchid’s stem or leaves. It really is that easy.

Orchid Crown Rot - Treatment and Prevention - Orchid Bliss

Apply 70% isopropyl rubbing alcohol or hydrogen peroxide directly to orchid leaves without diluting it. This will kill pests like mites, aphids, and mealybugs. Don’t ever pour rubbing alcohol or hydrogen peroxide into your orchid’s soil or you can damage the root system. Only use it to clean your orchid’s leaves.

Stop watering the plant and wait until the soil dries out completely to the touch. If the plant is potted, place it in front of a fan or move it outdoors to speed the drying process. Step 2 Fill a pitcher with a mixture of 1 qt. of water and 1 oz. of hydrogen peroxide.
